Christopher Joseph Conrad Clark, 47, of New Orleans, Louisiana, was born on November 17, 1977, to Alvin and Patricia Clark. He entered eternal rest on August 24, 2025.

Chris was a lifelong resident of New Orleans and received his education in the Catholic schools of the Archdiocese of New Orleans. He began his schooling at Our Lady of Lourdes and St. Monica, ultimately graduating from St. Augustine High School in New Orleans.

After high school, he attended Southern University for two years before answering a higher calling and enlisting in the United States Army. During his military career, he served with distinction as a decorated soldier, expert marksman, and systems operator. After his time in the military, Chris earned his degree in Electrical Engineering from ITT Tech, where he was honored to be the valedictorian.

Chris made his First Holy Communion in 1985 and received his Confirmation in 1992 at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church.
