Nothing can stop me now

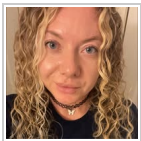

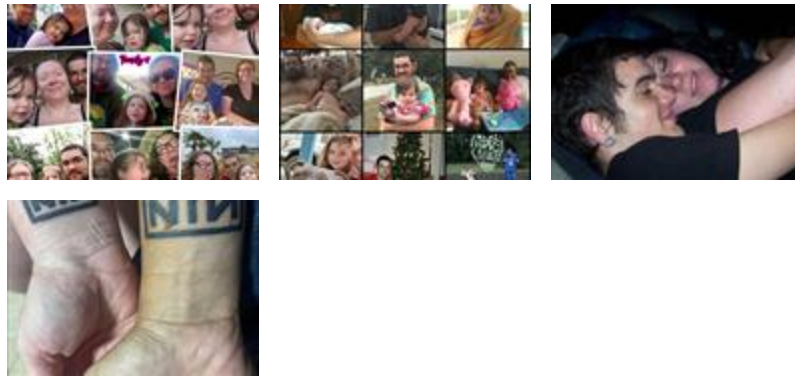
