Born on March 3, 1994, in New Orleans, Jarrell was the beloved son of Zennitria Stevenson and Drameka Arvie. He was raised in the New Orleans public school system and later earned his Equivalency Diploma from the Louisiana Community and Technical College System. During his youth, he was a proud participant in the Youth Empowerment Project (NOPLAY). Jarrell's life, although cut short, was filled with love, music, laughter, and deep connections.

Jarrell, known by many in the local rap scene as “Yung WrapHussle,” was a passionate music artist whose talent led to the release of several published

songs. Music was his voice, and through it, he expressed his life, struggles, and dreams. He also held jobs at Costco as a stocker and at Wendy's as a grill cook — always doing what he could to provide for his family.

To know Doody was to remember his infectious smile, charming personality, and undeniable good looks. He was truly a “ladies' man” and lived life on his own terms.

He was preceded in death by his loving mother Zennitria Stevenson, grandmother Sherry Arvie, grandfathers Edrick Clark and Tom Christmas, and his brother Christopher Conner.
